



WHEREAS, Ceasar C. Mitchell is a native of Atlanta, Georgia where he graduated from Benjamin E. Mays High School; he furthered his education at Morehouse College where he double-majored in English and Economics and earned a Bachelor of Arts degree, followed by his Juris Doctor degree from the University of Georgia School of Law; and



WHEREAS, Ceasar served as the 7th President of the Atlanta City Council, and served eight years as a citywide Councilmember prior to his tenure as president; he was known as an advocate for safer communities through specific initiatives including police foot patrols, and he championed key legislation facilitating economic revitalization in underdeveloped areas by authoring measures to create 4 of the city's 10 Tax Allocation Districts and supporting legislation for community input in the Beltline Project; and

Ceasar serves as a member of the Midtown Alliance Board of Directors, as several other advisory boards including former Board Chair of Hands on Atlanta, and Board Director for Points of Light, Inc., Atlanta Regional Commission, Georgia Municipal Association, and a nationwide taskforce of the National League of Cities; and



WHEREAS, Ceasar is a Henry Crown Fellow with the Aspen Institute and a former president of the Gate City Bar Association: in his capacities as a lawyer, elected official and civic leader, he has been named one of Atlanta's 100 most influential citizens and was featured in Georgia Trend's "Top 40 under 40" issue; and

Ceasar's greatest achievement is family; he and his wife, Tiffany Mitchell, are the proud parents of two daughters and one son;
