WHEREAS,

The Sickle Cell Consortium (SCC) is a US-based non-profit composed of a global network of sickle cell leaders, educators, and advocates; and



WHEREAS,

SCC partnerships consist of diverse stakeholders, including domestic and international community-based organizations, patient and caregiver advocates, medical and research advisors, industry manufacturers, and educators; and



WHEREAS,

SCC actively brings sickle cell patients and caregivers to the forefront of health education, research, legislation, advocacy, awareness, and policy; and



WHEREAS,

SCC has provided over \$100,000 in resources and financial support to sickle cell patients and caregivers; and



WHEREAS,

SCC has supported patients and caregivers with over \$250,000 in travel, lodging, and registration for the Annual Warriors Convention; and



WHEREAS,

SCC has provided virtual resources, including lectures, workshops, discussions, and panels to over 4,200 sickle cell patients and caregivers with travel restrictions;
