Request approval of recommended proposal - Fulton County Information Technology (FCIT), 18RFP110617B-BR, Network Refresh in the amount of \$4,489,063.74 with Presidio Networked Solutions, LLC (Norcross, GA) to refresh Fulton County's wired and wireless data network by replacing aging network devices and implementing a network based on current design principals and best practices. Effective upon issuance of Notice of Proceed for one year.

Summary & Background

Scope of Work: To update and refresh the Fulton County data network that supports delivery of all applications and services to the citizens and employees of Fulton County.

This award to Presidio Network Solutions is to refresh Fulton County's wired and wireless data network by replacing aging network devices and implementing a network infrastructure based on current design principals and best practices. Presidio will finalize the proposed design in conjunction with Fulton County staff. The new infrastructure will support the operations of government and provide access to critical information and services for citizens and employees. They will build the network configuration and implement the transition to the new redesigned network.

Community Impact: Fulton County government depends extensively on its network to deliver critical services to its citizens and perform the various operations of government. The data network is a essential component in the delivery of telephone services, as well as applications supporting public safety, court systems, public libraries and a myriad of internal services (e.g. Human Resources, Finance, Purchasing and Contract Compliance). Expansion of wireless network capacity will allow employees enhanced mobility to work and collaborate from many locations within the County. The enhanced wireless guest capacity will provide direct services to citizens in County facilities.

Project Implications: This proposal requires replacing over 1000 network devices. Every effort will be made to minimize the impact to county services and employees during migration. Transition of a building or floor to the new network infrastructure will usually require a brief outage for the building or floor. Such outages will be scheduled during non-critical hours and the occupants will be consulted to ensure minimal impact to the operation of government and delivery of services to citizens. For those departments that operate continuously we will work closely with the department leaders to ensure any outage is minimal and at a time of least impact to their operations.

The network refresh includes the implementation state of the art network management systems that will allow staff to have greater visibility into network health and performance. These tools will allow staff to identify, diagnose and correct issues more efficiently and effectively. These network management tools provide new flexibility and agility in making additions or modifications to the network.

The proposed design and new network devices include capabilities to segment parts of the network for stability and security purposing. Segmenting the network allows for containment of both network issues and security risks.

Community Issues/Concerns: Network migrations will be planned as to avoid interruptions and minimize impacts to operations of the government. Presidio has extensive experience in planning and implementing network migrations to minimal operational impacts.

Department Issues/Concerns: The existing data network was initially designed and implemented in 2008. The structure of the network while current in 2008 no longer reflects the best practices of current network design. Many of the network components have been in place since the initial deployment of infrastructure and have exceeded or are at end of their usable life. The components age opens the environment to security vulnerabilities and other technical risks. The existing network equipment continues to age it is becoming increasingly less reliable and eventually will become inoperable. The current network reflects performance capabilities available at the time of its design in 2008. The refreshed network will have greater capacity, faster communications speeds and ability to support more devices than our current environment. This will enable the refreshed Fulton county network to meet the increasing requirements of the county government to provide services to the citizens of Fulton County.

History of BOC Agenda Item: New Procurement.

In accordance with Purchasing Code Section 102-386, Renewal of annual licensing, maintenance and support agreements for intellectual property, the anticipated useful life of the intellectual property is a minimum of 10 years and the anticipated annual cost for maintenance, support and service agreement(s) and licensing fees in order to maintain the intellectual property over its useful life is estimated to be \$167,622.90 annually beginning FY2020.
