Damion joined the chart topping group, Guy, with his brother, Aaron Hall, and Teddy Riley; they created a sound called New Jack Swing which became the staple of music from the late 80's into the 90's; and

Guy went on to sell millions of records with albums like *Guy, The Future,* and *GuyIII*; Damion recorded, produced, and wrote his solo album, *Straight to the Point*, in 1994, and continues to produce various projects through his company, Hall of Fame Entertainment; and

Damion has expanded his production into the movie business with his first film, *Beyond the Lights*, with

several other projects in production; and



WHEREAS,

Damion is also a sought after public speaker and has worked with various foundations in the local community, including the Book Bank Foundation;
