TO SUPPORT THE OUTREACH EFFORTS OF THE FULTON COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES' DEFLECTION TEAM; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

9	WHEREAS, annually, the Fulton County Department of Behavioral Health and		
10	Developmental Disabilities ("DBHDD") provides services for over 2,600 people		
11	with mental health issues and Substance Use Disorders ("SUD") at five (5) sites		
12 13	throughout Fulton County; and		
14	WHEREAS, DBHDD services include screening, assessment, specialty		
15	outpatient treatment, and individual and group therapy provided through contracts with		
16	community-based providers; and		
17			
18	WHEREAS, in partnership with the Atlanta/Fulton County Prearrest Diversion		
19	Initiative, Inc. ("PAD"), DBHDD created the Fulton County Diversion and Deflection		
20	Recovery Program ("FDR") in 2023 to respond to substance use, promote public safety		
21	and support access to SUD treatment and recovery services for individuals in Fulton		
22	County, Georgia; and		
23			
24	WHEREAS, the Fulton County Deflection Team conducts deflection outreach to		
25	targeted areas of high crime and high usage in North and South Fulton to connect		
26	individuals with needed SUD services with the goal of preventing these individuals'		
27	involvement with the criminal justice system; and		
28			
29	WHEREAS, Intown Collaborative Ministries, Inc. (d/b/a as Intown Cares)("Intown		
30	Cares"), is a Georgia non-profit corporation that operates the Intown Cares Food Panti		
31	a client-choice food pantry open to anyone experiencing food insecurity; and		
32			
33	WHEREAS, the Atlanta Community Food Bank, Inc. ("Atlanta Food Bank") is a		

- 1 Georgia non-profit corporation that works with hundreds of community-based partners,
- 2 including food pantries, community kitchens, childcare centers, shelters, and senior
- 3 centers, to distribute an average of 10 million pounds of food each month, or
- 4 approximately 9 million meals to those who are food insecure in 29 counties across metro
- 5 Atlanta and north Georgia; and

**WHEREAS**, Georgia Harm Reduction Coalition, Inc. ("GHRC") is a Georgia non-profit corporation that engages in grassroots advocacy, research, and direct service aimed at supporting individuals made vulnerable by various factors, including drug use, sex work, overdose, gender-related issues, sexually transmitted infections ("STIs"), HIV, hepatitis, and other communicable diseases; and

**WHEREAS**, GHRC's primary objective is to facilitate closer access to prevention and health services free of charge for those involved in high-risk activities, irrespective of their choices, circumstances, or lifestyle; and

WHEREAS, Futon County Code ("FCC") § 1-117 allows the Board of Commissioners to exercise exclusive jurisdiction and control over collecting and appropriating money for its use and benefit, and for the promotion of health; and

**WHEREAS**, Intown Cares and the Atlanta Food Bank have offered to donate food to Fulton County for distribution by the Fulton County DBHDD Deflection Team as part of its community outreach; and

**WHEREAS**, GHRC has agreed to donate naloxone and fentanyl testing strips to Fulton County for use by the Fulton County DBHDD Deflection Team as a part of its outreach efforts to deflect those struggling with substance use issues from jail into treatment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby approves and accepts the ongoing food donations from Intown

1	Cares and the Atlanta Food Bank with an undetermined value on behalf of the Fulton		
2	County Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities' Deflection		
3	Team, for the purposes of providing healthy food to individuals in the community during		
4	the Deflection Team's outreach efforts.		
5			
6	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners		
7	hereby approves and accepts the ongoing naloxone and fentanyl testing strip donations		
8	from Georgia Harm Reduction Coalition, Inc. with an undetermined value for use by the		
9	Fulton County Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities'		
10	Deflection Team as part of its outreach efforts to deflect those struggling with substance		
11	use issues from jail into treatment.

13	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective when		
14	adopted, and that all resolutions and provisions of the Code of Laws in conflict with this		
15	Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
