AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE II, DIVISION 2, SECTION 2-79 OF THE CODE OF LAWS OF FULTON COUNTY RELATING TO THE CODE OF ETHICS TO REQUIRE THE FILING OF AN ANNUAL INCOME FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE STATEMENT FROM MEMBERS OF THE DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY OF FULTON COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has, by ordinance, established a Code of Ethics (Fulton County Code of Ordinances ("FCC), § 2-66, et seq.) governing minimum standards of conduct for County officers and employees; and

WHEREAS, among other provisions, the Code of Ethics requires that many Fulton County elected officials, employees, and members of boards file annual Income and Financial Disclosure Reports with the Clerk to the Commission (Code of Ordinances § 2-79); and

 WHEREAS, FCC § 2-67, defines the "officers or employees" of Fulton County whom must comply with the requirements of the Ethics Code to mean, "any elected officer of the county, any person appointed to a county board, commission, or agency by the board of commissioners, any person employed by the county, including contractual employees, and any person retained by the county or any agency of the county in a consulting capacity, who is exclusively obligated to the county for a period of 90 or more days"; and

WHEREAS, FCC § 2-67 further provides that the aforementioned definition "includes retired former employees and other former employees of the county during any period in which they are later employed or retained by the county or any county agency"; and.

 WHEREAS, FCC § 2-67, however, also states that the aforementioned definition "does not include members of advisory boards having no decision-making authority; provided, however, that county employees serving on the Advisory Committee of the Atlanta/Fulton County Water Resources Commission continue to be included within this definition while serving on that advisory committee"; and

 WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that to achieve the goal of creating transparency, open government and accountability, that the public interest is best served, in having the members of the Development Authority of Fulton County must file annually a financial disclosure report detailing all monies received from any source in carrying out the functions or duties required by their appointments; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Fulton County Code § 1-117, the Board of Commissioners has exclusive jurisdiction and authority to exercise such other powers as are granted by law, or are indispensable to their jurisdiction over County matters and County finances; and
