SYJTP Historical Program Data

- In 2017, Fulton County Board of Commissioners approved \$1,000,000 in funding to address juvenile crime.
 - \$500,000 was allocated for a Youth Crime Initiative Program RFP focusing on three categories of youth at risk.
 - \$500,000 was allocated to launch a jobs program to jump-start efforts focusing on summer intern employment opportunities with Fulton County and external employers.
- 2020-2021 - SYJTP did not occur due to COVID 19
- **2017-2024 - Total SYJTP Investment: \$2,659,776**
 - County General Fund Investment: \$1,659,776
 - American Rescue Program Act (ARPA) Fund Investment \$1,000,000

2026 SYJTP RFP

Summer Youth Job Training Program (SYJTP) was established as part of Fulton County's commitment to providing Fulton County teens with the opportunity to gain work experience, develop interpersonal skills, and learn and explore career interests while earning income during the summer.

- 2026 SYJTP contract dates: June 1, 2026 – August 31, 2026.
- Funding would support Fulton County Youth ages 16-24.
- The minimum SYJTP stipend would be no less than \$15/Hour for a minimum of 100 hours during the contract period.

Projected Impact by Funding Level:

- \$250,000 – Approximately 166 Youth served
- \$300,000 - Approximately 200 Youth served
- \$500,000 - Approximately 333 Youth served
