4	WHEREAS, through the adoption of House Bill 885 (Laws 201, Act 467, §
5	1, effective April 27, 2016) in the 2015-2016 Regular Session, the Georgia
6	General Assembly repealed O.C.G.A. § 31-3-3.1, which had allowed Fulton
7	County to operate its public health services through its internal Department of
8	Health and Wellness; and
9	WHEREAS, House Bill 885 further provided that the operation of public
10	health services in Fulton County was to transition from being a department within
11	the County to being an independent county board of health similar to the other
12	boards of health around the State of Georgia that were never incorporated into
13	county governments; and
14	WHEREAS, Fulton County therefore adopted Resolution Nos. 17-0298
15	and 17-0299 on April 12, 2017, dissolving the Department of Health and
16	Wellness and directing County staff to facilitate the creation of the Fulton County
17	Board of Health as an independent entity; and
18	WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Health was created as an
19	independent legal entity, with all powers and obligations of a county board of
20	health that are set forth in O.C.G.A. § 31-3-1, et seq. and as may be delegated
21	by the Georgia Department of Public Health and by and through the authorities
22	established in O.C.G.A § 31-2-1, et seq., O.C.G.A. § 26-2-370, et seq., and other
23	state laws as of July 1, 2017; and
24	WHEREAS, to facilitate a smooth transition for the new entity, Fulton
25	County and the newly established Fulton County Board of Health entered into an

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1	Intergovernmental Agreement (Agenda Item No. 17-0300) for the provision of
2	services and personnel from Fulton County to the Fulton County Board of Health
3	for a period of fifty (50) years; and
4	WHEREAS, the Service Level Agreement attached to the
5	Intergovernmental Agreement detailed those specific services that the County
6	would provide to the Fulton County Board of Health, with consideration for the
7	sun-setting of certain services as the Fulton County Board of Health develops the
8	capacity to operate those services on its own; and
9	WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Health has made great strides in
10	establishing its capacity to handle its own financial, information technology, and
11	human resources systems, among others; and
12	WHEREAS, Fulton County and the Fulton County Board of Health are
13	forever seeking the fulfillment of the same goal of ensuring that All People Are
14	Healthy within Fulton County; and
15	WHEREAS, greater financial control will enhance the effectiveness of the
16	Fulton County Board of Health; and
17	WHEREAS, the transition of financial services from Fulton County to the
18	Fulton County Board of Health is necessary in order to avoid multiple budget
19	close out periods due to the different fiscal year periods of Fulton County and the
20	county boards of health around the state, which currently results in inefficiencies
21	in the administration of the Fulton County Board of Health annual budget due to
22	the need to freeze spending during these close out periods twice a year; and

1 WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that the time is right to 2 encourage and support additional financial responsibility for the Fulton County 3 Board of Health; and 4 WHEREAS, Fulton County Code of Laws ("FCC") § 1-117 gives the Board 5 of Commissioners exclusive authority over the affairs of the County, and the 6 Board of Commissioners is authorized to enter into and amend 7 Intergovernmental Agreements with other entities pursuant to GA CONST Art. 9, 8 § 3, ¶ I. 9 NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of 10 Commissioners of Fulton County hereby supports the continuing transition of the 11 Fulton County Board of Health, and directs the Fulton County Department of 12 Finance to fully transfer control and administration of the financial services provided by the County pursuant to the Service Level Agreement to the Fulton 13 14 County Board of Health, with the requirement that complete transfer of all 15 financial services and administration to the Fulton County Board of Health shall 16 be completed on or before June 30, 2021; and 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Finance Department shall take all necessary steps within ten (10) days after the passage of this Resolution to no 18 19 longer restrict or oversee the Fulton County Board of Health's ability to direct and 20 prioritize the use of all the revenue, fees, grants and funding that it generates or 21 receives; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that beginning on October 1, 2020, the 22 23 Chief Financial Officer shall provide and place into the checking account of the

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1 Fulton County Board of Health an equal monthly allocation of the budgeted funds 2 allocated by Fulton County for public health activities through the Fulton County Board of Health each fiscal year, rather than providing support on a 3 4 reimbursement basis; and 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer shall work 6 with the District Health Director of the Fulton County Board of Health and her 7 designees to phase out Fulton County's budget close-out responsibilities for the 8 Fulton County Board of Health, and shall ensure financial files and documents 9 are held for the appropriate time for audit purposes and are provided to the 10 Board of Health auditor for prior year single audits in accordance with Generally 11 Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP). 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that on or before October 1, 2020, Fulton County and the Board of Health shall negotiate a new formula to reduce the 13 14 Board of Health's reimbursement to Fulton County to account for those services 15 described in the Service Level Agreement that the County no longer provides, or 16 is phasing out. 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Attorney shall be authorized to prepare an amendment to the existing Intergovernmental 18 19 Agreement and the Service Level Agreement to reflect the transfer of financial 20 controls of the Fulton County Board of Health and the reduction in required 21 services from the County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVE	D, that title to all vehicles given or leased to	
the Board of Health shall be transferred to the Board of Health effective July 1,		
2021.		
BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED	, that this Resolution shall become effective	
upon its adoption, and that all resol	utions and parts of resolutions in conflict with	
this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
