Ronald was well known as the voice of APS Lakewood Stadium as the sports announcer for many years; and

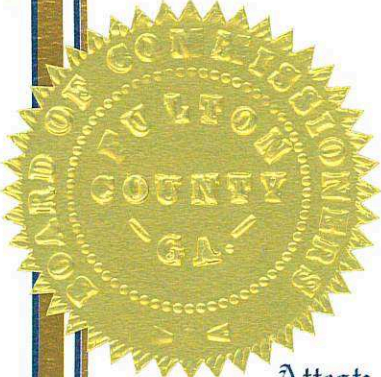


**WHEREAS,**
