WHEREAS, Rohan Dalal is a sophomore at Georgia Institute and when he was in high school, he was a National Merit Scholarship Semi-Finalist, Kimberly-Clark Foundation Bright Futures Scholar, Thomas J. Watson Memorial Scholarship Award winner, Governor's Honors Program Math Finalist, and Regeneron Science Talent Search Scholar and Biomedical Science Award winner; and



WHEREAS, Rohan has excelled in many areas of scouting, with achievements including Assistant Senior Patrol Leader, Troop Guide, and mentor to younger scouts; and



WHEREAS, Rohan has satisfied the strenuous requirements necessary to attain the rank of Eagle Scout, which include the design and construction of a low balance beam along with a set of tiles aids that help in developing balance and coordination skills; he also designed and constructed two outdoor benches with storage for tools for the Spectrum Autism Support Center; and



WHEREAS, Rohan will be recognized by friends, family and fellow Scouts for his attainment of the rank of Eagle Scout during a Court of Honor Ceremony on Saturday, May 16, 2026 at Johns Creek Presbyterian Church;
