1 2	RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH SUPPLEMENT FOR THE TAX COMMISSIONER AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
3 4	WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has recently comprehensively evaluated the
5	compensation of many employees, elected officials and appointed executives; and
6	WHEREAS, on November 17, 2021, in Agenda Item No. 21-0913, the Department of
7	Human Resources Management ("DHRM") presented the Board of Commissioners with a
8	proposal to establish new salaries and/or county supplements for elected and appointed officials
9	to the extent allowed by law and where such authority is vested in the Board of Commissioners
10	("BOC"); and
11	WHEREAS, DHRM proposed a County supplement to bring the Tax Commissioner's base
12	compensation (salary plus supplement) in line with current market rates based on the size of the
13	Tax Commissioner's operations and the compensation of his counterparts in other counties; and
14	WHEREAS, the base salary of tax commissioners is set forth in O.C.G.A. § 48-5-183; and
15	WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 48-5-183(b)(3), the General Assembly by local law or
16	the county governing authority may establish a county supplement for the tax commissioner; and
17	WHEREAS, neither the General Assembly nor the Board of Commissioners has provided
18	a county supplement for the Fulton County Tax Commissioner; and
19	WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to create a county supplement for the
20	Fulton County Tax Commissioner.
21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners hereby adopts
22	a county supplement for the Fulton County Tax Commissioner as outlined in the addendum to the
23	Salaries and Supplements Schedule attached hereto.
24	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective retroactive to April
25	13, 2022 when other elected officials had their County supplement increased.
26	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that DHRM shall review the Tax Commissioner's County
27	supplement in tandem and as part of future county-wide classification and compensation salary
28	surveys.
29	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with
30	this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.


