Franklin was approached by a group of citizens asking what sort of government the delegates had created and his

answer was: "A republic, if you can keep it."; and

WHEREAS, each year, September 17 is observed across the United

States as Constitution Day, celebrating the rights granted to

each citizen of this great nation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County recognizes the Constitution of the United States as the foundation of our government, expresses ongoing commitment to upholding the

Constitution, and declares Wednesday, September 17, 2025 as "CONSTITUTION DAY 2025" in Fulton County, Georgia.
