A RESOLUTION BY THE FULTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PANEL AGREEMENT WITH THE URBAN LAND INSTITUTE ATLANTA FOR THE PURPOSE OF HELPING TO IDENTIFY REDEVELOPMENT OPPORTUNITIES IN SUPPORT OF THE AIRPORT MASTER PLAN FOR THE FULTON COUNTY EXECUTIVE AIRPORT – CHARLIE BROWN FIELD; AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN OR THE COUNTY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PANEL AGREEMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Fulton County, Georgia, is a political subdivision of state Georgia and committed to the practice of optimizing its assets for the purpose of providing the highest level of governmental services and improving the quality of life for all residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Executive Airport – Charlie Brown Field and the community in which it is located are at critical stages of their economic life cycles and requiring innovative ideas for redevelopment that will improve the quality of life for community residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, in preparation for development of an Airport Master Plan for the Fulton County Executive Airport – Brown Field, in accordance with the requirements of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) and the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT), Fulton County and the Urban Land Institute, on behalf of the Urban Land Institute Atlanta ("ULI"), entered into a Technical Assistance Panel ("TAP") Agreement effective the 8th day of January, 2020 (Agenda Item #) 20-0004; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the TAP is to provide a technical assistance panel related to the redevelopment strategies for Fulton County Executive Airport – Charlie Brown Field; and

WHEREAS, due to the spread of COVID-19 pandemic in Fulton County and the metro Atlanta area, the original timing for deliveries under the TAP requires an extension of time; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County, Georgia hereby approves the First Amendment to the Technical Assistance Panel Agreement with the Urban Land Institute

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Fulton County, Georgia (the "County") entered into an Technical Assistance Panel ("TAP") Agreement (the "Agreement") effective the 8th day of January, 2020 with ULI – The Urban Land Institute on behalf of the Urban Land Institute Atlanta ("ULI"), wherein ULI is to provide a technical assistance panel related to the redevelopment strategies for Fulton County Executive Airport – Charlie Brown Field (the "Airport"), via Agenda Item # 20-0004; and

WHEREAS, due to the spread of COVID-19 in the County, the original timing of the TAP has been rescheduled; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to amend the Agreement by amending the second paragraph of the Agreement, titled <u>Services</u>; <u>Schedule of Performance</u>, to provide for the new dates for certain services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the County and ULI agree as follows:

- 1. Reference to "March 2020" in <u>Services; Schedule of Performance</u> is changed to "September 30, 2020 and October 1, 2020".
- 2. Reference to "June 30, 2020" in <u>Services; Schedule of Performance</u> is changed to "December 30, 2020".

All other terms, conditions and provisions of the original Technical Assistance Panel ("TAP") Agreement shall remain unchanged and shall continue in full force and effect.
