1 2 3 4 5 6	A RESOLUTION URGING THE CONSOLIDATION OF CERTAIN FULTON COUNTY CLERK OF COURT OPERATIONS UNDER THE FULTON COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT CLERK; DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER TO ASSIST WITH FACILITATING SUCH CONSOLIDATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
7	WHEREAS, Fulton County, Georgia, (the "County") is a political subdivision of the
8	State of Georgia, existing as such under and by the Constitution, statutes, and laws of
9	the State; and
10	WHEREAS, the County's Board of Commissioners ("BOC") desires a more
11	judicious and efficient use of the County's tax dollars, infrastructure, and personnel as it
12	relates to clerk of court operations in the County's Superior, State and Magistrate Courts
13	(collectively "Clerk Operations"); and
14	WHEREAS, such judiciousness and efficiency can best be accomplished through
15	the consolidation of Clerk Operations under the County's Clerk of Superior Court
16	("Superior Court Clerk"); and
17	WHEREAS, consolidation of Clerk Operations would reduce overall costs to the
18	County by eliminating duplication of infrastructure, personnel, training, processes, and
19	functions; and
20	WHEREAS, pursuant to GA. CONST. art. IX, § 1, para. III, the Superior Court Clerk
21	is a constitutionally elected position; and
22	WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-6-51, the Superior Court Clerk may
23	undertake additional court clerk duties by concurrently holding the office of clerk for other
24	courts within the County; and
25	WHEREAS, pursuant to 1999 Ga. L. 3781 (codified as Fulton County Code § 10-
26	184(a)), the Judges of the Fulton County's State Court ("State Court Judges") elect the

- 1 Chief Clerk of the Fulton County State Court ("State Court Clerk"); and
- 2 **WHEREAS,** on March 16, 2016, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-10-105(b), and with
- 3 the consent of the Superior Court Clerk, the BOC adopted Resolution No.16-0263
- 4 appointing the Superior Court Clerk ("Appointment") to serve as the Clerk of the Fulton
- 5 County Magistrate Court ("Magistrate Court Clerk"); and
- 6 **WHEREAS,** the BOC recognizes that reversing this Appointment would be a costly
- 7 and complicated endeavor that would require building new infrastructure that has not
- 8 previously existed in Magistrate Court, altering the budget of a constitutional officer, and
- 9 transferring employees possibly to the disruption and detriment of the courts and offices
- in which they serve; and
- WHEREAS, the expense of reversing the Appointment provided in Resolution No.
- 12 16-0263 will ultimately be borne by the tax paying residents of Fulton County; and
- WHEREAS, the BOC intends to maintain the Appointment of the Superior Court
- 14 Clerk to the position of Magistrate Court Clerk; and
- WHEREAS, the BOC desires that the Superior Court Clerk also serve as the State
- 16 Court Clerk.
- NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board
- of Commissioners urges the State Court Judges to elect the Superior Court Clerk to serve
- 19 as the State Court Clerk.
- 20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners
- 21 urges the Superior Court Clerk to consent to serving as the State Court Clerk if so elected,
- which—in conjunction with the Appointment as the Magistrate Court Clerk set forth in
- 23 Resolution No. 16-0623—would result in consolidated Clerk Operations serving the

1	Fulton County Superior, State, and Magistrate Courts.
2	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners
3	urges all stakeholders to work cohesively to achieve and/or maintain the consolidation of
4	Clerk Operations under the Superior Court Clerk.
5	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that if all necessary parties (the Superior Court
6	Clerk, the Superior Court Chief Judge, the State Court Judges, and the Chief Magistrate)
7	agree, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners directs the County Manager and
8	County departments to facilitate consolidation of Clerk Operations and bring forth any
9	budgetary or legislative actions for which further BOC approval is required to achieve the
10	desired consolidation.
