










Libraries in Fulton County Accessible to White and Black Patrons





Snapshot of Healthcare Inequities in Fulton County, 2024



ER Visits represents number of Fulton County residents who visited the ER in 2024. Years of Potential Life Loss (YPLL) is a measure of the number of years not lived by each Fulton County resident who died before reaching age 75. Infant Mortality Rate is measured by dividing the number of infant deaths by live births in Fulton County and multiplying by 1,000.
