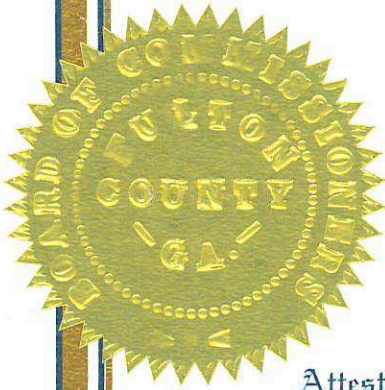


WHEREAS,
