Summary & Background

Scope of Work: The Department of Arts & Culture (FCAC) recommends the approval of the resolution establishing the Fulton County Poet Laureate who will engage diverse communities using poetry as a vehicle for literary competency, cross-cultural and multi-disciplinary artistic dialogue and understanding for the citizens and visitors of Fulton County.

The goals for the Poet Laureate are to broaden the awareness of poetry, express the spirit of Fulton County's culture through poetry, expand and enhance literacy and access to literature in its varying forms and to generally promote the literary arts and raise the level of discourse around the artistic form.

An open call for applications and nominations via artcall.org was completed in mid-September 2019 with 16 submissions. Eight submissions were then moved forward to the selection committee for assessment of the poets' submitted work as well as his or her ability to broaden the awareness of poetry, enhance literacy, and promote the literary arts in Fulton County. Three finalist were invited to interview with the selection committee in January 2020.

Dr. Karen J. Head was the most successful in laying out a plan for promoting and enriching Fulton County's literary community and poetry among citizens.

KAREN J. HEAD (PhD University of Nebraska) is Executive Director of the Communication Center at the Georgia Institute of Technology, as well as the Associate Chair and Associate Professor in the School of Literature, Media, and Communication. Since 2006, she has been a Visiting Scholar at Technische Universität-Dortmund, Germany, where she serves as the primary consultant for their academic center. Her research areas focus on writing and communication theory and pedagogical practice, especially in the following areas: higher education rhetoric, sustainable and innovative pedagogy and space design implementation, development of writing centers, writing program administration, communication ecologies, technical communication, business communication, multidisciplinary communication, and creative writing.

In 2012-13, she was part of the GT team awarded a Gates Foundation Grant to develop one of the first Massive Open Online Courses (MOOCs) focused on college writing, and she has published several articles about the experience. Her book Disrupt This!: MOOCs and the Promises of Technology (University Press of New England, 2017) describes her experience teaching a MOOC and the attendant pressure on professors, especially those in the humanities, to embrace new technologies in the STEM era. She has also published four books of poetry (Sassing, My Paris Year, Shadow Boxes, and On Occasion: Four Poets, One Year), co-edited the poetry anthology, Teaching as a Human Experience: An Anthology of Poetry, and has exhibited several acclaimed digital poetry projects. She was the 2010 winner of the Oxford International Women's Festival Poetry Prize.

An award winning teacher, Head's courses center on analyzing, critiquing, evaluating, and creating a variety of texts that demonstrate an understanding of audience and adaptation of multimodal and multi-literacy rhetorical strategies and tools. In 2013, she won Georgia Tech's CETL/BP Junior Faculty Teaching Award, and has won the Class of 1934 Course Survey Teaching Effectiveness Award several times. She also serves as the editor of Southern Discourse in the Center: A Journal of Multi-literacy and Innovation. In summer 2016, she became the editor of the international poetry journal, Atlanta Review.

Community Impact: Enhance literary competency throughout Fulton County, engage a diversity of citizens in poetry specifically and how the literary arts intersect with other artistic forms more broadly.

Department Recommendation: Approval of the resolution to establish the Fulton County Poet Laureate.

Project Implications: The poet laureate will serve to enhance the arts through poetry and a greater engagement of citizens and visitors with the literary arts.

Department Issues/Concerns: Approval of the poet laureate recommendations is essential to addressing the need to elevate poetry to assist the County in addressing literacy challenges for its citizens.

# A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POET LAUREATE FOR FULTON COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Fulton County Arts Council ("Arts Council") was created by the Fulton County Board of Commissioners on October 17, 1979, to advise the Board of Commissioners generally with regard to the expenditure of funds in support of the Arts in Fulton County, to determine the needs of the Arts in Fulton County, and to review and channel Arts programs and contracts; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the Fulton County Department of Arts and Culture believes the Arts 10 are essential to the quality of life of the citizens of Fulton County and they provide a 11 benefit to the economic and social health of communities throughout Fulton County; and

WHEREAS, the stated Mission of the Fulton County Department of Arts and
Culture is to coordinate with the Arts Council to ensure all citizens of Fulton County
have access to the Arts; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners is committed to enriching the Arts
provided to all citizens in Fulton County in line with Fulton County's Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners wish to establish a Poet Laureate for a two year term conditioned upon satisfactory annual review of appointment by administering department. Administrative and programmatic oversight for the Poet Laureate program shall be the responsibility of the Fulton County Department of Arts & Culture; and

WHEREAS, Establishing a Poet Laureate for Fulton County shall aid County
efforts to engage diverse communities using poetry as a vehicle for literary competency,
cross-cultural and multi-disciplinary artistic dialogue and understanding; and

WHEREAS, establishing a Poet Laureate for Fulton County would inspire 4 creative expression in others that raises the level of discourse and interaction in our 5 everyday lives. The Poet Laureate will be responsible for collaborating with local, 6 national and international literary agents and others key stakeholders including Fulton 7 County Libraries while planning and executing an annual series of public poetry and 8 fiction readings, lectures, symposia, and occasional dramatic performances and other 9 programmatic activities that enhance and expose the literary landscape of Fulton 10 County to its citizens and visitors; and 11

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of
Fulton County hereby establishes a Poet Laureate for Fulton County with Dr. Karen J.
Head serving as the inaugural Poet Laureate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners authorizes the
Fulton County Department of Arts and Culture to coordinate with the Fulton County Arts
Council, and others, to ensure that the objectives of this Resolution are effectuated.

18 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall become effective when 19 adopted, and that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution 20 are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
