Greg studied at William Carey University in Mississippi, and began his career on the radio there at WORV-WJMG, followed by WBLX 93 in Alabama, KMJQ in Houston, K-104/KKDA in Dallas, all before his move to Atlanta in the early 90's; and

WHEREAS,

Greg began his career at Atlanta's V-103 radio station in June 1995 and quickly established himself as one of the city's most popular radio personalities; his is known for his signature catchphrase, "It's 6 o'clock, it's 6 o'clock, time for Greg Street to Rock"; and

in 2015, Cash Money Records hired Greg to oversee their content division, the book publishing arm of the hip hop empire; and



WHEREAS,

Greg is one of the country's top collector of high-end sneakers, which led him to establish the annual *Sneaker Friends* convention in 2006; the convention brings sneaker collectors from all over the globe to enjoy exclusive sneakers, live music performances, and the hip hop culture; and



WHEREAS,

Greg is also the creator of *WeNeed2Read*, an initiative to boost literacy and comprehension levels in elementary and high school students enrolled in inner city schools, which has donated thousands of dollars in scholarships to participating students;
