Request approval for 2018 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds and approve projects for (1) an agreement with the City of Fairburn for Infrastructure and Utility Relocation near Dodd Street and Campbell Street (\$162,487); and (2) an agreement with Union City for Lester Road Pedestrian Sidewalk Improvements that meet ADA standards (\$162,487); Authorize the Chairman to disburse funds, and execute and administer contracts and other related documents consistent with the federal programs and this Board action; Authorize the County Attorney to approve these contracts as to form and to make modifications thereto prior to execution. The funds are 100% grant funded.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) regulations require jurisdictions that receive an annual formula allocation of federal funding from HUD. conduct a public comment period regarding funding for proposed Annual Action Plan activities and any amendments to the Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plan documents prior to adoption.

Citizens were encouraged to attend and participate in the public hearings to assist the County in finalizing its proposed activities for the 2018 program year. The Department of Community Development published an ad for the 2018 Annual Action Plan in the Wednesday, May 16, 2018 newspaper and posted on the County websites. The notice was also sent by email to citizens, community groups and non-profit agencies that may have been interested in participating in this process. The Department afforded citizens the opportunity to provide written comments until 5:00 n.m. on Monday. June 20, 2018.

Comments received will be included as an attachment in the final document. The 2018 proposed Annual Action Plan activities direct that the application of funds must benefit low-to moderate residents of Fulton County as directed by the Board of Commissioners and as required by the rules and regulations that govern the use of federal funds in administering the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's programs. Staff reviewed the proposed activities that are included in the 2018 proposed Annual Action Plan Document for eligibility under the guidelines of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG). The Chairman of the Fulton County Board of Commissioners is authorized to disburse all Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Housing Investment Partnership Program (HOME) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds for the purposes of implementing said programs and to executed on behalf of Fulton County all supplemental intergovernmental agreements, contracts and related documents, as necessary and consistent with these programs and program amendments as approved by the Board of Commissioners.

Department Recommendation: Approve the 2018 Annual Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the allocation for approximately \$2,961,064.00 (CDBG: \$1,916,230.00; HOME: \$861,925.00 and ESG: \$182,909.00) in federal grant dollars. Project Implications: Receiving the funds will increase the Department of Community Development's budget to provide services to low income citizens without using General Funds.

Community Issues/Concerns: The Department of Community Development hosted four community meetings and no concerns were provided by the attendees.

Department Issues/Concerns: Department recommends receiving the grant dollars to maintain staff and provide services in cooperation with local municipalities and non-profit agencies.
