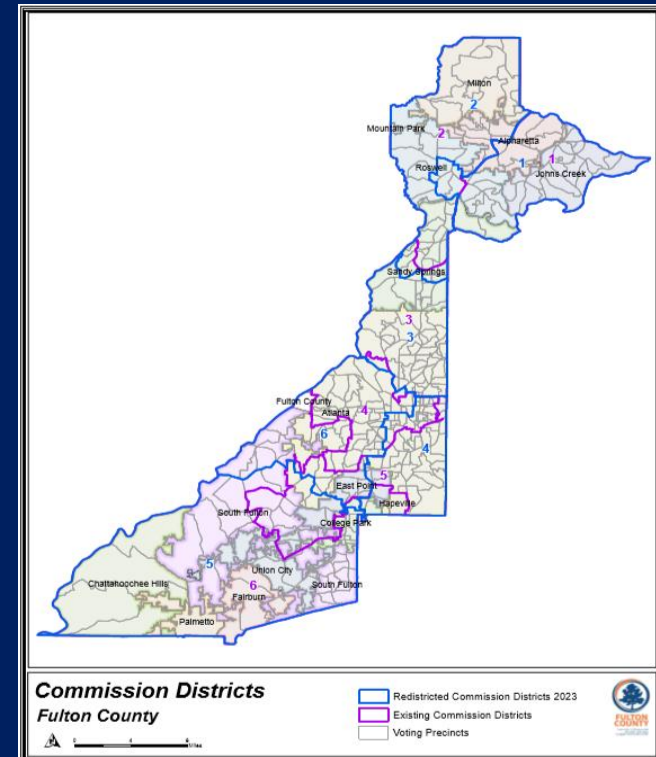

Election Day and Advance Voting locations will be determined by the contest requiring a runoff.

If a statewide runoff is required, the following estimated number of voting locations will be utilized:

- Advance Voting Locations: 30
- Election Day Locations: 250
