The City of Sandy Springs Recreation and Parks Department is the City's BEE CITY USA sponsor and chooses to support and encourage healthy pollinator habitat creation and enhancement through the planting of native, pollinator- and bird- friendly plants as part of landscaping design and green spaces; and

as part of the designation, the city committed to creating and adopting an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) plan designed to prevent pest problems, reduce pesticide use, and expand the use of non-chemical pest management methods;
