Judge Williams is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., a member of the Clark Atlanta University Athletic Hall of Fame, a life member of the NAACP, and past Chairman of the Atlanta-Fulton County Library Board of Trustees; and

Judge Williams was on the original management team of The Omni Coliseum, now State Farm Arena, and later served as Executive Director of the Atlanta-Fulton County Recreation Authority, and later served as General Manager of the Richmond County Civic Center; he also served as Director of Facility Management for Paine College in Augusta, Georgia; and




WHEREAS,
