WHEREAS,

Georgia State Representative Letitia “Tish” Naghise was a native of Atlanta, Georgia and earned her Associate’s degree from Atlanta Metropolitan State College, and both her Bachelor and Master degrees from Clayton State University; and



WHEREAS,

Rep. Naghise began her political career as a local team leader for President Barack Obama’s 2008 and 2012 presidential campaigns, and continued as a field organizer for the Democratic Party of Georgia’s “Coordinated Campaign” in 2016, and a field organizer for Jon Ossoff’s campaign in the 2017 Georgia 6th congressional district’s special election; and



WHEREAS,

Rep. Naghise was named as a Georgia delegate to the 2020 Democratic National Convention, and in November of 2022, she was elected to the Georgia House of Representatives for District 68; and



WHEREAS,

Rep. Naghise worked as a paralegal and co-owned a trucking company before she began serving in office, and prior to her election, she was an engagement organizer for Georgia Conservation Voters;

Rep. Naghise was married to her husband, Charles, with whom she shared two sons;
