8	the "Technology Fund Resolution"), a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "A";

10	WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-6-60.1, the Clerk of Superior Court
11	("Clerk") is the constitutional officer elected by the citizens of Fulton County to
12	protect and preserve their court and land records and, pursuant to O.C.G.A. §
13	15-6-96, is the sole custodian of all original filed records that the Clerk is required
14	by law to retain in the Clerk's office; and
15	WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-6-61(a)(5), the Clerk is required by
16	law to keep all the books, papers, dockets, and records belonging to the office
17	with care and security and to keep the papers filed, arranged, numbered, and
18	labeled, so as to be of easy reference; and
19	WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-6-61(b), the Clerk is authorized by
20	law to store for computer retrieval any and all records, dockets, indices, or files;
21	provided that any automated or computerized record-keeping method or system
22	shall provide for the systematic and safe preservation and retrieval of all such
23	records and with the same security and integrity as paper filing and record-

keeping; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk is required to participate in the state-wide uniform automated information system as provided for by O.C.G.A. § 15-6-61(15) and provide data about real property transactions electronically to the Georgia Superior Court Clerks' Cooperative Authority; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. §15-6-68, the Clerk must provide an electronic, computer-based indexing system to the public for certain types of land records; and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Clerk that increased reliance upon technology in Superior Court, including the growing body of statutory requirements relating to land records in the largest county with the highest population in the State, imposes upon the Clerk greater responsibility for the maintenance of existing systems to ensure that the function and capacity of her systems are stable and sufficient to fulfill her duties; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk has determined that setting aside revenue from certain revenue-generating agreements related to e-recording of land records would create an income stream that would be available to defray some of the technology – related expenses that are critical to the performance of her duties as they relate to the e-recording, indexing and transmission of land records; and WHEREAS, in order for the Clerk to set aside revenue from her

agreement with the Georgia Superior Court Clerks' Cooperative Authority in the Historical Plat Image Compensation Agreement (the "Agreement"), the Fulton County Board of Commissioners must specifically authorize the Clerk to set

1	aside and use the funds generated from the Agreement for the purposes	
2	contained in the Technology Fund Resolution; and	
3	WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners, recognizing the	
4	broad and increasing costs of technology, desires to amend the Technology	
5	Fund Resolution to include the revenue generated from the Agreement;	
6	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of	
7	Commissioners hereby authorizes the Clerk to set aside funds from the	
8	Agreement into the Superior Court Clerk's Technology Fund.	
9	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the purpose of the Technology Fund	
10	shall continue to be to augment funding provided by the Board of Commissioners	
11	for the operation of the Clerk's Office to meet rising technology-related expenses	
12	related to e-recording of land records.	
13	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the authorization contained in this	
14	Resolution shall be retroactive to January 1, 2021.	
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the remainder of Resolution 18-0168	
16	remains unchanged.	
17	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that resolutions and parts of resolutions in	
18	conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

2	court order relating to electronic filing, storage, transmission of, and public
3	access to court and land records; and
4	WHEREAS, the Clerk is required to participate in the state-wide uniform

6	provide data about real property transactions electronically to the Georgia
7	Superior Court Clerks' Cooperative Authority; and
8	WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. §15-6-68, the Clerk must provide an
9	electronic, computer-based indexing system to the public for certain types of land

11	WHEREAS, it appears to the Clerk that increased reliance upon

23	shall be to augment funding provided by the Board of Commissioners for the	

1	operation of the Clerk's Office to meet rising technology-related expenses related		
2	to e-recording of land records.		
3	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Finance Department is directed to		
4	set up a Superior Court Clerk's Technology Fund, a dedicated account to set		
5	aside income generated by contracts with vendors providing e-recording of land		
6	records which may be entered into from time to time by the Board of		
7	Commissioners on behalf of the Clerk, said income to be used solely by the Clerk		
8	for land records system technology-related expenses, specifically land records		
9	system upgrades, maintenance, development and training; workplace design and		
10	reconfiguration to accommodate conversion to digital processes; and to promote		
11	increased productivity and performance.		
12	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective		
13	upon its adoption, and that all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with		
14	this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
