RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FULTON COUNTY, GEORGIA TO USE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 STATE AND LOCAL FISCAL RECOVERY FUND MONEYS TO PROVIDE RENTAL ASSISTANCE TO RESIDENTS AND STAKEHOLDERS ON AN AS NEEDED AND WHEN NEEDED BASIS THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2021 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$4 MILLION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Fulton County, Georgia ("Fulton County") is a political subdivision of the State of Georgia ("State"), existing as such under and by the Constitution, statutes, and laws of the State; and

- WHEREAS, Fulton County residents and stakeholders have been impacted by the threat and spread of a novel coronavirus known as SARS-CoV-2 ("COVID-19"), including renters being evicted; and
- WHEREAS, the United States Congress has passed the "American Rescue Plan Act of 2021" ("Act"), which was signed into law by the President of the United States on Thursday, March 11, 2021, to provide State and local governments with direct allocations from the Act's State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund ("SLFRF"), based upon their respective populations; and
- WHEREAS, Fulton County has received an allocation of money from SLFRF, and pursuant to prior resolutions and actions of the Board of Commissioners, Fulton County has dedicated such money to various services for residents and stakeholders in response to the COVID-19 pandemic; and
- WHEREAS, in addition to the allocation of SLFRF money to Fulton County, Fulton County has also received an allocation of money through the Act's Emergency Rental Assistance Program ("ERAP"); and
  - WHEREAS, in response to the need of its residents and stakeholders, Fulton County has led the State in the distribution of ERAP money and has exhausted all of its allocated ERAP money for 2021; and
  - WHEREAS, Fulton County has requested from the State and the US Treasury a reallocation of \$25 million in ERAP money, which is currently under review and consideration; and
  - WHEREAS, in order to meet the continuing needs of Fulton County residents, Fulton County proposes to authorize the use of money received from SLFRF to provide rental assistance to its residents and stakeholders on an as needed and when needed basis through December 31, 2021 in an amount not to exceed \$4 million by reallocating previously dedicated SLFRF money to provide rental assistance, all as authorized by and consistent with the Act; and
  - NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners hereby approves, directs and authorizes the Fulton County Department of Finance to reallocate money received from SLFRF under the Act
