



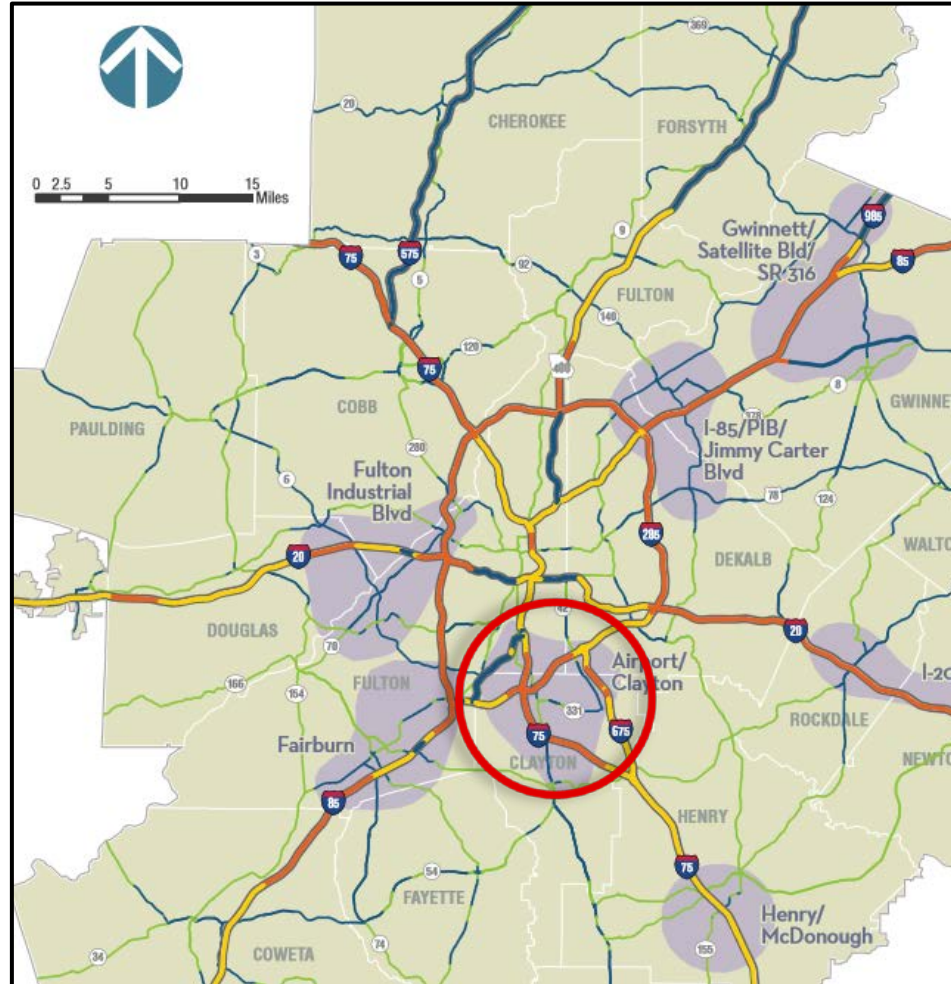

- Atlanta Regional Commission completed Freight Plan Update in June 2016
- Recommendation includes Freight Cluster Plans
- Set aside funding in 2017 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Solicitation
- Purpose of Plan is primarily to identify first and last mile freight connections
- Plan will focus on:
 - Transportation Planning
 - Traffic Engineering
 - Safety
 - Intersection Design
 - Cost Estimation

*Per 2015 Atlanta Regional Freight Mobility Plan Update



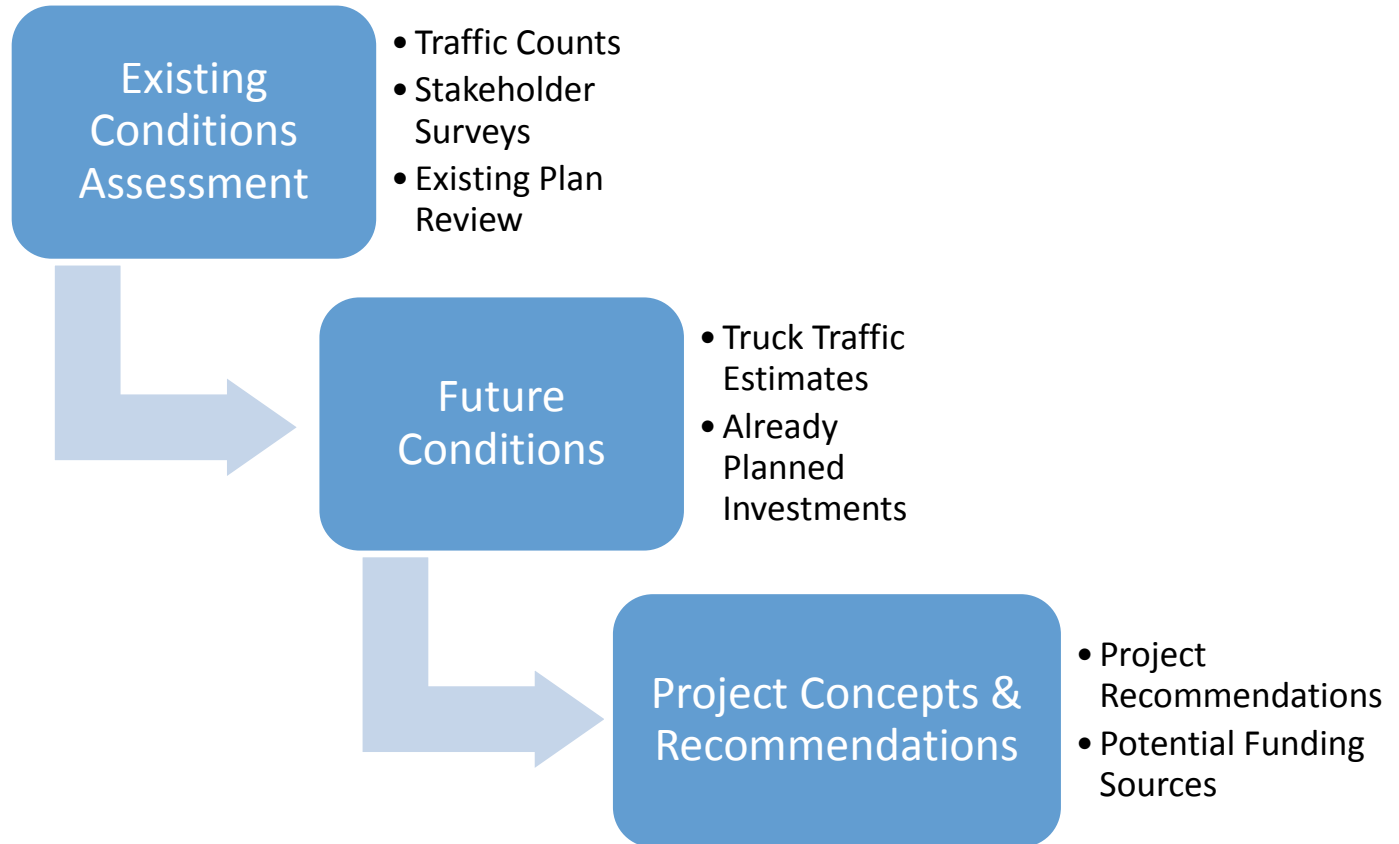
Freight Cluster Plan Application

- \$312,000 Study Total

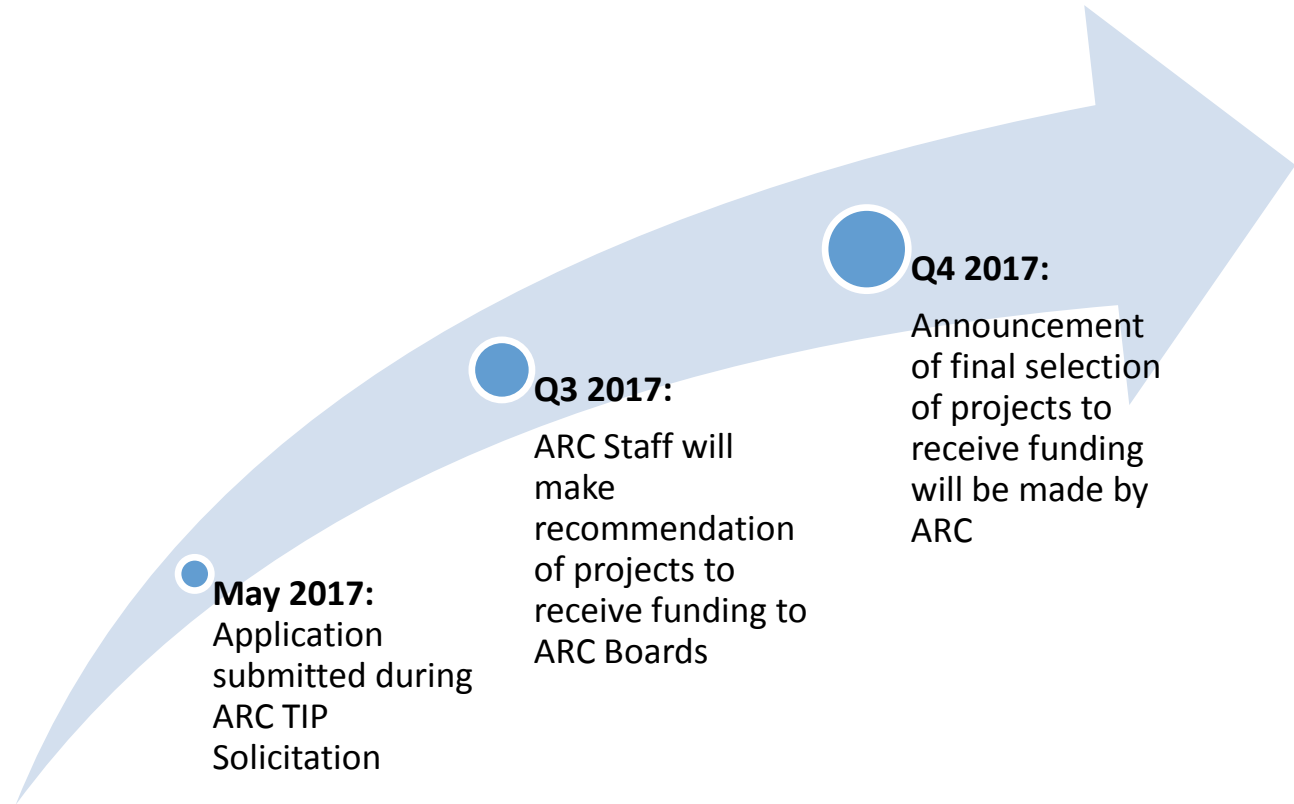
