**WHEREAS,** Zina is a former executive board member of both Women in Film (WIFA), and Vice President of East Coast and Operations Manager of NABFEME - National Association of Black Female Executive in Music and Entertainment for 20 years; she and her business partner, Jennifer Nash, created *60 Seconds to Stardom*, an actor showcase, as well as produced films, including *Is It Major*, and *Bo Legs: Marvin Arrington, Sr., an Atlanta Story*; and
