A RESOLUTION TO EXTEND EMERGENCY PURCHASING AUTHORITY OF THE CHAIRMAN AND COUNTY MANAGER FOR COVID-19 RELATED PURCHASES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, beginning in March 2020, Fulton County, Georgia has been impacted
by the threat and spread of a novel coronavirus known as SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19); and
WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, to control the spread of the virus, President
Donald Trump issued a "Proclamation on Declaring a National Emergency Concerning
the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak"; and

10 WHEREAS, on February 24, 2021, President Joseph Biden extended the 11 "Proclamation on Declaring a National Emergency Concerning the Novel Coronavirus 12 Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak"; and

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2020, Georgia Governor Brian Kemp, by Executive Order 03.14.20.01, declared a public health emergency in the State of Georgia by Executive Order, including the area encompassing Fulton County to assist health and emergency management officials across Georgia by deploying all available resources for mitigation and treatment of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, Georgia Governor Brian Kemp's Executive Order 03.14.20.01, which
 was extended every thirty (30) days by the governor, expired on July 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on June 30, 2021, Georgia Governor Brian Kemp, by Executive Order 6.30.21.01, which has been extended every thirty (30) days by the governor, declared that the State of Georgia is experiencing an ongoing public emergency due to the impacts of COVID-19 on the economy, supply chain, and healthcare infrastructure, and declared a state of emergency for continued COVID-19 recovery in the State of Georgia, which includes the area encompassing Fulton County; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the public health emergency caused by the spread, and potential 2 spread, of COVID-19 has negatively impacted Fulton County's public health, supply 3 chain, and healthcare infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020, the Board of Commissioners ("BOC") passed Resolution No. 20-0237 declaring authorization for the Chairman and the County Manager to execute any documents, including but not limited to contracts, memoranda of understanding or declarations necessary to ensure the maintenance of critical governmental functions during the pandemic; and

9 WHEREAS, this authority granted to the Chairman and County Manager, as
10 extended, expires on December 3, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the BOC wishes to continue the authorization granted to the County 11 Manager and Chairman to make COVID-19 related emergency purchases from any 12 funding the County has received, to include from Federal Emergency Management 13 Agency (FEMA) through the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency 14 Assistance Act (Stafford Act) (42 U.S.C §§ 5121-5207), Consolidated Appropriations Act 15 (H.R. 133, 116th Cong. (2020)), Emergency Rental Assistance Program (15 U.S.C. § 16 17 9058c), Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security Act (C.A.R.E.S Act) (Pub. Law 116-136, March 27, 2020, 15 U.S.C. § 9001 et seq.), and American Rescue Plan Act (18 H.R. 1319, 117th Cong. (2021)) using the same process that was put into place to handle 19 20 C.A.R.E.S. Act funded projects consistent with Fulton County Code of Ordinances § 102-385. 21

1	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners hereby
2	extends the time period of COVID-19 related emergency purchasing authority to the
3	County Manager and Chairman until January 2, 2022.
4	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman or the County Manager are
5	hereby authorized to execute any documents, including but not limited to contracts,
6	memoranda of understanding or declarations necessary to ensure the maintenance of
7	critical governmental functions.
8	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall become effective upon
9	adoption and shall continue until further notice.
