A RESOLUTION TO AMEND CHAPTER 38 (HUMAN RELATIONS), ARTICLE I (IN GENERAL), SECTION 38-1 AND CHAPTER 154 (PERSONNEL), ARTICLE I (IN GENERAL), SECTION 154-3(A) OF THE FULTON COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO ADOPT A POLICY AGAINST DISCRIMINATION ON THE BASES OF GENDER IDENTITY AND GENDER EXPRESSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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WHEREAS, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners ("Board") is dedicated to a policy of non-discrimination within Fulton County and is committed to creating an environment that fosters and enhances diversity in the work place; and

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WHEREAS, Fulton County desires to safeguard the rights and opportunities of all persons to be free from discrimination in employment; and

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WHEREAS, on August 19, 1992, the Board enacted Chapter 38, Article I, Section 38-1 and Chapter 154, Article I, Section 154-3, which prohibit discrimination generally and in employment based on race, color, religion, national origin, gender, age, disability or sexual orientation; and

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WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interest of the County, its residents and its employees to amend its non-discrimination policies in Fulton County Code of Laws Section 38-1 and Section 154-3 to encompass additional protected classes including gender identity and gender expression; and

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WHEREAS, the Board has authority pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Georgia, Article 9, Sec. 2 § 1(a), to adopt reasonable ordinances, resolutions, or regulations relating to its affairs for which no provision has been made by general law and which is not inconsistent with the Constitution or any local law applicable thereto.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board hereby amends Section 38-1 of the Fulton County Code of Laws as follows:

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Sec. 38-1. Nondiscrimination Policy.

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It is the policy of the Fulton County that there will be equal opportunity for every citizen without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, gender, age, disability, or sexual orientation, gender identity or gender expression.

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33 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Board hereby amends Section 154-3(a) of the Fulton County Code of Laws as follows:

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(a) It is the policy of Fulton County that there will be equal opportunity for
every citizen and employee based upon merit without regard to race,
color, religion, national origin, gender, age, disability, <del>or</del> sexual
orientation, gender identity or gender expression.
BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that this Resolution shall take effect upon its
adoption, and all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict with this Resolution are
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hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
