Veterans Empowerment Organization has served over 6,500 veterans to date, 38,000 meals served each year, has provided 22,000 shelter nights for veterans, and has completed 3,700 mental health sessions, and hosts over 5,000 volunteers at their campus each year; and

Veterans Empowerment Organization's funding is provided in part by the Fulton County Board of Commissioners under guidance of the Department of Community Development's Community Solutions Program;
