SITUATION

Senior Services provides rides through 2 transportation contracts.

1. Traditional Bus Service (Transdev)



Dialysis, Neighborhood Senior Centers, Adult Day Health, Multipurpose, IDD, Community Trips, Medical Appointments

2. Uber/Lyft Service (Common Courtesy)





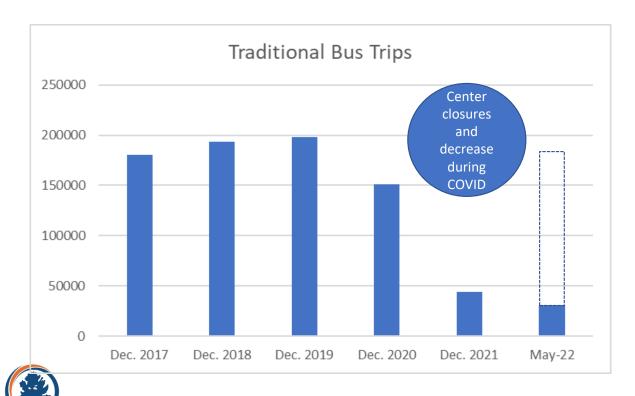


Medical Appointments, Community Trips (including Multipurpose)

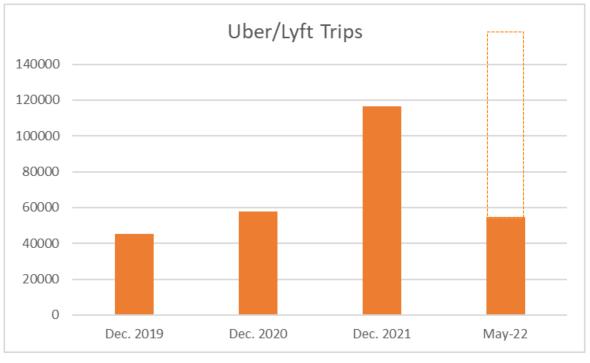


Uber/Lyft has experienced exponential growth since inception while traditional bus

service is relatively the same.

Why?

Increased confidence levels

- Allayed fears
- Decreased misconception of safety
- Low exposure to others vs bus

Same day booking

- Minimal wait times
- Perceived safety and reduced exposure during pandemic

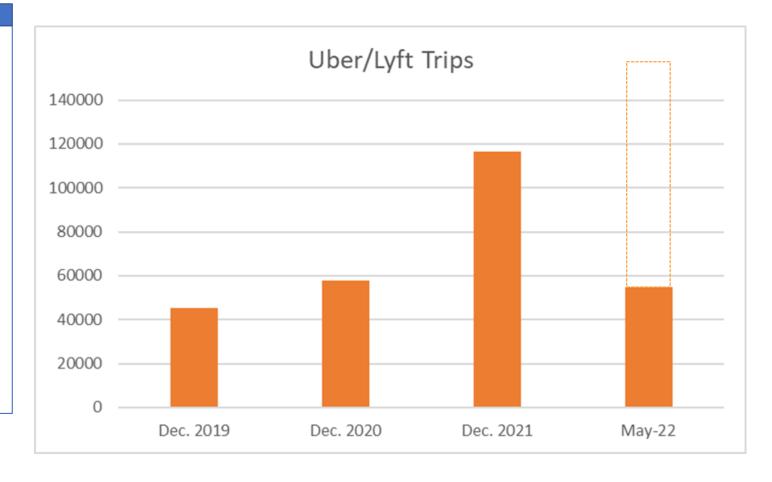

Recommendations

- 1. Traditional Bus Service Approve RFP, allocate \$732,393.48 for FY22 contract and fully fund contract through 2026
- 2. Uber/Lyft Service Allocate additional \$1.8M for FY22 contract, maintain monthly ridership at 1,455 seniors max. and suspend new registrations through October 2022
- 3. Seek additional funding during mid-year review
 - 1. \$1.8M Uber/Lyft
 - 2. \$732,393.48 Traditional (6-month costs July 1 December 31, 2022)



4. Plan implementation of long-term program sustainability measures
