Project H.E.L.P. (Humanity Evolves from Loving People) is a hands-on servicing experience dedicated to providing nourishment, provisional resources, and living necessities for underserved communities and the less fortunate in Atlanta; and



WHEREAS,

the five pillars of Project H.E.L.P. are Women & Children, Career Development, Partnership Growth, Community Engagement, and Healthcare & Mental Health; and



WHEREAS,

the organization was started in September of 2020 by its Founder and President, Daniel Farr, with the idea of helping those that are vulnerable in the community by preparing food and care packages; and



WHEREAS,

by the end of its first full year of operation in 2021, Project H.E.L.P. had 16 service events, 127 volunteers, 17 sponsors, provided over 75 health screenings and 25 Covid-19 vaccinations, and provided over 1400 meals; and



WHEREAS,

in commemoration of Juneteenth 2022, Project H.E.L.P. will partner with Safehouse Outreach, a local shelter in Atlanta, to serve homeless individuals by providing meals, mobile showers, free haircuts, health checks and vaccination services, free MARTA cards, and personal hygiene kits;
