Natalyn Mosby Archibong is the oldest of five children born to Nathaniel "Nate" Mosby, a Morehouse alumnus and the second African American elected to the DeKalb County Board of Commissioners, and Gwendolyn Mosby, a Spelman alumnus and an Atlanta public school teacher; and



WHEREAS,

Natalyn was elected to represent District #5 (Sweet Auburn, Edgewood, Kirkwood, East Atlanta, East Lake) in 2001; and



WHEREAS,

Natalyn has been instrumental in bringing affordable housing initiatives to the city, securing funding for over twenty acres of greenspace, two new fire stations, new libraries, infrastructure upgrades, and working on public safety issues by improving the relationship between the community and police; and



WHEREAS,

Natalyn's proudest accomplishment is her daughter, Miriam Archibong, who is a product of Atlanta Public Schools and a graduate of Spelman College, Harvard Graduate School of Education, and the University of Pennsylvania Law School;
