1 **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ADOPTION OF THE 2022 FULTON COUNTY** 2 3 MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN PURSUANT TO THE **DISASTER MITIGATION ACT OF 2000** 4 5 WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 ("DMA") provides the 6 legal framwork for the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) mitigation, 7 planning requirements for state, local, and tribal governments as a condition of 8 9 mitigation grant assistance; and **WHEREAS.** the DMA requires that states as a condition of disaster assistance. 10 with support from local government agencies, develop hazard mitigation plans to 11 12 prepare for and reduce the potential natural hazards; and **WHEREAS**, the Atlanta-Fulton County Emergency Management Agency 13 ("AFCEMA") is the Emergency Management Agency for Fulton County, and serves as 14 the lead coordinating agency for mitigation planning and coordinates with the Hazard 15 Mitigation Planning Committee ("HMPC"); and 16 WHEREAS, AFCEMA has developed a Mulit-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation 17 18 Plan as a result of a countywide effort to idenfiy and address certain vulnerabilities that exist prior to and during a disaster in Fulton County; and 19 20 **WHEREAS**, Fulton County submitted its Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan to FEMA and FEMA determined the County's Multi-Jurisdictional Mitigation Plan 21 22 acceptable in July 2022; and WHEREAS, DMA requires that local hazard mitigation plans be formally 23 24 adopted by the governing body of Fulton County and each participating jurisdiction. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of 25 Commissioners: 26 (1) Adopts in its entirety the 2022 Fulton County Multi-Jurisdictional Hazard 27 Mitigation Plan ("FCMHMP"); 28 (2) Will use the adopted plan to guide pre-and post-disaster mitigation of the 29 hazard mitigation of the hazard identified; 30
