

Proclamation



WHEREAS,

On the evening of Thursday, September 22, 2022, a woman was assaulted in a restroom at the Fulton County Courthouse and once reported, the Sheriff's department immediately sent out a description of the assailant; and



WHEREAS,

District Attorney Investigator DaJuan Walker was on his way home from work when he recognized a man walking on Pryor Street who fit the description of the attacker; he pursued on foot until the suspect was out of sight; and



WHEREAS,

Investigator Walker flagged down a Georgia State University maintenance truck who drove Investigator Walker in the direction of the attacker, but lost sight of him; and



WHEREAS,

on the street level above, District Attorney Assistant Chief Investigator Thomas Ricks spotted the attacker, who appeared to be following another female Georgia State student, and detained him; and



WHEREAS,

Investigator Walker is a native of Harlem, New York and worked as a project manager and financial analyst in the healthcare field before joining the Atlanta Police Department as an officer in 2016; he joined the Fulton County District Attorney's Office as a senior investigator in the Special Victims Division's Domestic Violence Unit in 2022;



NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Fulton County Board of Commissioners recognizes Investigator DaJuan Walker for his heroic actions, quick thinking, and for his commitment to keeping our streets safe, and does hereby proclaim Wednesday, October 5, 2022 as "**DAJUAN WALKER APPRECIATION DAY**" in Fulton County, Georgia.
