 - Four (4) Senior Centers Roswell, Mills, Hapeville, & Camp Truitt
 - Medical Examiner's Office
 - Joyner Bridge
 - Assembly Hall Building [Suite 2085, Assembly Hall, Tax Commissioner's Office, DREAM]
 - Charles Carne Building [Suites G-40 and J-150]
 - Health Facilities [College Park Regional & Oak Hill]
- Burst fire sprinkler lines, domestic water lines, HVAC Coils, low/no water pressure
- Approximately 20K square feet of facility space damaged
- ☐ Approximate Recovery Cost: \$1.8M-\$2.2M

 - Three (3) burst domestic water lines

 - Two (2) burst fire sprinkler heads in fitness room

 - Burst HVAC Coil on mezzanine level

Cause

Three (3) burst domestic water lines

Current Status

- All flooring removed in affected areas
- Drying/dehumidification completed
- ☐ Drywall replacement began on 1/3/2023

Next Steps

- Source replacement carpet
- Determine multipurpose hall replacement flooring

- Flooring reinstallation in progress


Next Steps

- Restore drywall





Three (3) fire sprinkler heads along exterior wall

Current Status

- 85% of affected carpet removed
- Drying/dehumidification in progress (Time intensive due electrical raceways in floor)
- Sourcing replacement carpet


Next Steps



- Assembly Hall restored


Next Steps

ADDITIONAL FACILITY ISSUES



☐ Fulton Jail at Rice St.

- Four (4) burst HVAC Coils (2 of 4 repaired)
- Low incoming water pressure resolved by COA

☐ Camp Truitt Senior Center

- Burst domestic water line in Kitchen(repaired)
- No interior damage due to kitchen flooring

■ Roswell Senior Center

- Burst exterior water main (repaired)
- No interior damage

South Fulton Library

Parking deck fire line burst (repaired)

☐ South Service Center

➤ Low water pressure - restored

☐ North Service Center

Burst exterior make-up water line repaired

☐ College Park Regional Health

> Low/no water pressure - restored

☐ Oak Hill Family, Child Adolescent Center

- > Burst fire sprinkler line repaired
- > Low/no water pressure restored
- ➤ Ceiling repair to begin on 1/5/23

■ Medical Examiner's Office

- > Burst HVAC Coil
- > Replacement coil being sourced
- Ceiling tile replacement scheduled for 1/6/2023

PREVENTIVE MEASURES MOVING FORWARD



■ DOMESTIC WATER LINES

- Notification to end-users to leave faucets running (inside/outside)
- > Identify specific locations at each facility to provide best protection

☐ FIRE SPRINKLER LINES

- Research cost effective/efficient solutions to prevent freezing of lines
- ASSESS EXISTING NOTIFICATION SYSTEM
 - > Evaluate current alarm notification technology to ensure all needs are met
 - Review current response & escalation protocols
