WHEREAS,

Chloe Bailey was born on July 1, 1998 in Atlanta, Georgia, and along with sister, Halle Bailey, caught the eye of superstar songstress Beyoncé who signed them to her Parkwood Entertainment record label after they got their start making cover videos on YouTube; and

WHEREAS,

the duo released 2 EPs, 2 albums; earned 5 Grammy Award nominations, 8 BET Award Nominations, 7 Soul Train Music Award nominations, 2 iHeartRadio Music Award nominations, 2 NAACP Image Awards, Billboard Women in Music's Rising Star Award, and several other awards and nominations; and also starred in the Freeform series *Grown-ish* for several seasons; following the success of their 2nd studio album *Ungodly Hour* released in 2020, the musical pair set out on solo paths; and

WHEREAS,

Chlöe recently released her debut album "In Pieces," to critical praise after having released beloved fan favorite singles *Treat Me*, *Surprise*, *For The Night* ft. Latto, *How Does It Feel* and *Cheatback* ft. Future; her debut single *Have Mercy* has been watched more than 93 million times on YouTube alone. She debuted *Have Mercy* with a performance at the MTV VMA Awards and performed *Surprise* at last year's BET Awards, stealing the show; she's since appeared and performed on The Today Show, The Tonight Show, The Jennifer Hudson Show, the Drew Barrymore Show, The Tamron Hall Show and several others; most recently she faced off on the hit NBC television show "That's My Jam" hosted by Jimmy Fallon; and

WHEREAS,

Chlöe has starred in *Praise This*, *Swarm*, *Jane*, *Black-ish*, *Let it Shine*, *Joyful Noise*, *Gospel Hill*, *Meet the Browns*, *Last Holiday*, *The Fighting Temptations*, and will star in several upcoming productions; and as a philanthropist has participated in a "Teen Mental Wellness Courtside Chat" and, through a collaboration with her sister and PINK donated \$75,000 to Sad Girls Club, a nonprofit and she is very supportive of girls and women pursuing STEM education. She has supported organizations like "Black Girls Code"; and

WHEREAS,

another career highlight for Chlöe was singing the National Anthem during Game 3 at the 2022 World Series; her solo debut album titled *In Pieces* was released on March 31, 2023 to critical acclaim;
