Dr. Gunby was President and Senior Pastor of Green Pastures Christian Ministries, Inc., a ministry she started with her husband, Ronald E. Gunby, in 1979 as Green Pastures Christian School; and

Dr. Gunby was also a noted speaker and author of three books: *The Plumline*, *Through Shadows of Death*, and *Courageous Women – Chosen to Lead*; she also co-authored *Failure the Womb of Success*; and

Dr. Gunby's achievements also include the musical production, *King of Glory*, and she served on the Board of Trustees of Beulah Heights University, the South DeKalb Church Coalition, Teen Challenge of Georgia, Fellowship of Metropolitan Atlanta Churches, and various other boards and committees; in 2006, she started Green Pastures College of Theology under the auspices of North Carolina College of Theology; and
