6 7	WHEREAS, Fulton County, Georgia, (the "County") is a political subdivision of the
8	State of Georgia, existing as such under and by the Constitution, statutes, and laws of
9	the State; and
10	WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners ("BOC") desires a more judicious and
11	efficient use of the County's tax dollars, infrastructure, and personnel as it relates to court
12	administration functions in the County's Superior, State and Magistrate Courts
13	(collectively "Court Administration Functions"); and
14	WHEREAS, pursuant to O.C.G.A. §§ 15-6-27 and 15-6-28(a), the Chief Judge of
15	the Fulton County Superior Court ("Superior Court Chief Judge") is authorized to employ
16	a superior court administrator ("Superior Court Administrator") and assign their duties and
17	responsibilities; and
18	WHEREAS, pursuant to 1999 Ga. L. 3781 (codified as Fulton County Code § 10-
19	184(b)), the State Court Judges are authorized to elect a court administrator ("State Court
20	Administrator"); and
21	WHEREAS, pursuant to Fulton County Code § 10-184(b), the Chief Judge of the
22	Fulton County State Court ("State Court Chief Judge") is authorized to assign the duties
23	and responsibilities of the State Court Administrator; and
24	WHEREAS, pursuant to 2015 Ga. L. 4178 (codified as Fulton County Code § 10-
25	354), the Chief Magistrate Judge of Fulton County ("Chief Magistrate") serves as the

Magistrate Court Administrator but may designate someone else to serve in that

1 administrative capacity; and

- 2 WHEREAS, the BOC desires that the Superior Court Administrator also serve as
- 3 the State and Magistrate Court Administrators.
  - NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners urges the State Court Judges to elect the Superior Court Administrator to serve as the State Court Administrator.
  - **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners urges the Chief Magistrate to designate the Superior Court Administrator to serve as the Magistrate Court Administrator.
  - **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners urges the Superior Court Chief Judge, the State Court Chief Judge, and the Chief Magistrate to consent to the assigning of duties of State Court Administrator and Magistrate Court Administrator to the Superior Court Administrator.
  - **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Fulton County Board of Commissioners urges the Superior Court Chief Judge, the State Court Judges, and the Chief Magistrate to work cohesively to facilitate the consolidation of Court Administration Functions under the Superior Court Administrator.
  - BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that if all of the necessary parties agree (i.e., the Superior Court Chief Judge, the State Court Judges, and the Chief Magistrate), the Fulton County Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes and directs the County Manager and County departments to facilitate consolidation of the Court Administration Functions and bring forth any budgetary or legislative actions for which further Board of Commissioners' approval is required to achieve the desired consolidation.
