ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 101-36(b) OF THE FULTON COUNTY CODE RELATING TO THE SELECTION PROCESS FOR THE VICE-CHAIRMAN OF THE FULTON COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS WHEREAS, the current policy set forth in Fulton County Code § 101-36(b), adopted on January 24, 2018, allows the board of commissioners to select its vicechairman based on member seniority, dependent on their prior and current service in that capacity; and

WHEREAS, the board of commissioners desires to adopt the former policy of Fulton County Code § 101-36(b) which required an election, by four affirmative votes for its vice-chairman position, from amongst all members; and

WHEREAS, the board of commissioners desires to require all members to have served at least two years on the board prior to being elected as vice-chairman; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Commissioners of Fulton County, Georgia that Fulton County Code § 101-36 (b) shall be amended to read as follows:

(b) The board of commissioners, by four affirmative votes, shall select elect a vice-chairman at the first regular meeting held in January, and the vice-chairman so elected selected shall be authorized to preside at meetings of the board of commissioners in the absence of the chairman and fulfill all of the duties of the chairman due to the death or vacancy of the chairman. The board member selected to serve as vicechairman shall be chosen from the members of the board of commissioners on a rotation based on seniority. If two or more board members are of equal seniority; the selection shall be made on the basis of the numerical order of the respective districts. No board member shall serve as vice-chairman a second year as board vice-chairman until the all member members has have served at least two years one year on the board.
