

FULTON COUNTY JAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY

BACKGROUND

Fulton County will undertake a feasibility study to determine options for the Futon County jail. Key drivers of the study include:

- Current facilities present maintenance, security and pandemic management challenges
- □ Facility design does not reflect incarceration science/trends



OBJECTIVES

To assess the overall needs of the County's jail services and evaluate the feasibility of a new facility, purchased facility or improvements to the existing facility to address the long term needs of Fulton County. Specific objectives include:

- Assess space and service needs
- Present innovative space design and programming options
- Determine the best location for a facility
- Provide cost and financing scenarios
- ☐ Ensure a "best practices" approach to pretrial incarceration



- ☐ Options for the jail including refurbishing/expansion, leasing of existing facility, or construction of new jail.
- □ Factors to be considered include demographic trends, trends in pre trail incarceration, and service/support requirements
- ☐ Analysis will identify cost, staffing, and timing of options
- □ Consultant must have experience in analysis of large, urban, complex court and jail systems
- □ RFP award targeted for January 2022 with 9 month duration
