**Scope of Work:** The proposed 323 Milton Avenue Lateral Project, a residential project, requires a connection to the County's sewer system. Fulton County development regulations require that all new sewer line connections acknowledge Fulton County's ownership interests in the area(s) in which a connection is being made to the County's sewer system prior to the issuance of a Land Disturbance Permit. The easement area to be conveyed to the County consists of 688 square feet and is located in Land Lots 1250 and 1271 of the 2<sup>nd</sup> District 2<sup>nd</sup> Section of Fulton County, Georgia.

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**Community Impact:** The community will benefit from the extension of the County's sewer system and the addition of public sewer access to a residential property.

**Department Recommendation:** The Department of Real Estate and Asset Management recommends acceptance of the easement dedication.

**Project Implications:** Easement dedications by the owner of record to Fulton County are made a part of the public record and grant Fulton County access to perform construction, maintenance and upgrades to the County's sewer system once the proposed improvements are installed.
