Summary & Background: Fulton County has been requested to conduct Special Referendum Elections for the City of Fairburn in conjunction with the General Election on November 8, 2022 and Runoff Election on December 6, 2022.

Per action of the Board of Commissioners on August 7, 2019, that in even-numbered years when Fulton County is holding a regularly scheduled Primary, Primary Runoff, General Election or General Election Runoff, the County will pay the costs of conducting municipal and school district elections.

Scope of Work: Intergovernmental Agreement for Fulton County to conduct Special Referendum Elections for the City of Fairburn in conjunction with the General Election on November 8, 2022 and Runoff Election on December 6, 2022.
