**Scope of Work:** The proposed Verizon Roswell 1 MEC Project, a commercial development, requires the installation of a water vault. Fulton County development regulations require that all new water line connections acknowledge Fulton County's legal access to the area(s) in which a water service line connection is being made prior to the issuance of a Land Disturbance Permit. The easement area to be conveyed to the County consists of 477 square feet and is located Land Lots 737 and 738 of the 1<sup>st</sup> District, 2<sup>nd</sup> Section of Fulton County, Georgia.

**Community Impact:** The community will benefit from the extension of the County's water system and the addition of a commercial data center

**Department Recommendation:** The Department of Real Estate and Asset Management recommends acceptance of the easement dedication.
